2017 BEC Summer School Edition

This BEC event was first presented back in 1982. With the 36th edition coming up, we hope to welcome participants from as many Member Associations as possible.

The BEC Summer School is a one week training camp. It is a combination of a training camp for talented junior players and a coach education course open to all European nations. The event is run by Badminton Europe, in cooperation with carefully selected high profile staff coaches.

Coach Education - Level 2 Course

For the second time Badminton Europe will organise a BWF Level 2 Coach Education course as part of BEC Summer School. This course will be based on the BWF Coach Level 2 material. Candidates who successfully pass the course will become certificated BWF Level 2 Coaches.

Nominations

Every Member Association is invited to nominate up to 6 players and 4 coaches to take part in the 2017 BEC Summer School.

For nominated coaches it is important that they are ranked in order of preference in case of limited amount of coaches per country can be accepted. To have a balanced participation Badminton Europe would welcome any nominations with equal numbers of female and male coaches.

Please keep in mind that there is a limited space at the BEC Summer School. In recent years we have experienced massive interest from Member Associations in nominating participants. Therefore it is possible that the number of nominations exceeds the number of available places. That means that nominating a participant does not guarantee entry.

We want to ensure your coaches to benefit as much as possible from our staff coaches and their training programme, therefore badminton courts should not become overcrowded.
