Romania Para-Badminton Timeline

Date	Activities
April 2016	Start of initiative after a discussion with Mr. João
	Matos in Slovenia advising us to start para-
	badminton based on possible relationships with
	NPC, now that para-badminton will be a
	Paralympic sport from 2020.
August 2016	We identify the person who will first start para-
	badminton in Romania (Alina Popa) as a
	specialized coach.
26th September 2016	We created the para-badminton section on our
	website (http://www.badminton.ro/para-
	badminton) in which we promote the local
	activities which will take place in Lasi - Romania
	and try to make the sport as visible as possible.
October 2016	Participation of coach (Alina Popa) at the para-
	badminton education course in Holland from
	which she can gain important confidence,
	information and knowledge for her future
	activity.
November 2016	Start of collaborations with Paralympic sport
	organizations in Romania (like NPC), from
	which we can gain valuable information regarding where to promote this activity best (as
	in social environment) and to actually make it
	known throughout the entire Paralympic
	movement in Romania.
March 2017	By this time, we hope to have an established
	para-badminton center in Lasi (with several
	players), which we can use as a landmark for
	our activity and then can try to identify the next
	person to start the activity in Bucharest, capital
	of the country. The long-term objective is to
	have 2-3 noticeable centers around the country
	where we can train athletes for para
	competitions.
