Invitation:	<p>Each Member Association of Badminton Europe is invited to nominate up to 6 players and 4 coaches to attend 2017 BEC Summer School.</p> <p>All training sessions are conducted in English, it is therefore important that <u>all players and coaches</u> can understand and communicate in English.</p>
Age and level of players:	<p>It is recommended that players participating should be in the U17 age group (players born in 2001-2002). However the emphasis remains to ensure that there is a high quality of players attending the BEC Summer School. It is therefore acceptable to nominate U19 players. All players should be national level players.</p>
Dates:	<p>Saturday 8 – Saturday 15 July 2017</p> <p>Participants are asked to arrive before 18:00 on Saturday 8 July 2017 and depart after breakfast on Saturday 15 July 2017.</p>
Venue:	<p>Multipurpose Sports Hall Podcetrtek Zdraviliska cesta 23 3254, Podcetrtek Slovenia</p>
Accommodation:	<p>Participants will reside in shared rooms (max 4 participants per room), which have their own bathroom.</p> <p>Hotel Breza and Hotel Village Lipa Zdraviliska cesta 24 SI-3254 Podcetrtek Slovenia http://www.terme-olimia.com</p>
Staff coaches:	<p>Skilled and experienced staff will be working with participant coaches and players at the Summer School.</p>

Coaches Course:	The Shuttle Time material and the BWF Level 2 Coach Education material will be presented to coaches at this year's BEC Summer School. Coaches who successfully pass the course will be certificated Shuttle Time Teachers and BWF Level 2 Coaches.
Travel details:	<p>Pick up from:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ljubljana Airport (Aerodrom Ljubljana) • Ljubljana train station (Slovenske železnice) <p>The local organiser will arrange transport from/to the airport/ train station free of charge.</p>
School fee:	<p>€ 450 per participant</p> <p>Full board and lodging is included. This amount will be invoiced by Badminton Europe.</p> <p>The full amount € 450 must be paid to Badminton Europe in advance upon receipt of invoice. Bank charges have to be paid by the National Associations and will not be accepted by Badminton Europe.</p>
Withdrawal:	Cancellation of reservations can be accepted until 12 th June 2017. Amounts paid, with the exception of reservation fee of € 50 per person (preparation costs, administration, staff etc.) will be refunded before this date. After the 12 th June 2017 no money can be refunded and the full participant fee of € 450 has to be paid.
Insurance:	<p>Players and coaches participate at their own risk. They must be covered on their own or by National Associations.</p> <p>Neither Badminton Europe nor Slovenian Badminton Federation accepts responsibility for this.</p>
