Standardised National Planning



Rationale:

- Ensure better return on investment (BWF and CCs)
- More targeted approach to supporting projects
- Increase probability of project sustainability
- Increase participation beyond schools

Shuttle Time implementing country



- A national Shuttle Time Co-ordinator has been appointed
- A delivery team of Shuttle Time tutors have been trained
- A national implementation plan has been developed
- Delivery and promotion of Shuttle Time activities are conducted for teachers and children on an annual basis
- Communication and regular reporting of courses is established between national Shuttle Time Co-ordinator and the CC

Standardised National Planning

Shuttle Time National Planning and Reporting Document

This Shuttle Time Planning and Reporting Document should be fully completed by National Badminton Associations, currently implementing or wishing to implement the BWF Shuttle Time Schools Badminton Programme.

To ensure maximum impact of the Shuttle Time Programme globally, the BWF and Continental Confederations will target equipment, financial and expert support to those countries which can demonstrate the following:

- 1- A long-term, strategic Shuttle Time Implementation plan is in place and approved by National Association Board
- 2- Partnerships are established nationally with key stakeholders, who can support the project and its sustainability
- 3- National Badminton Association is in 'good standing' as a BWF Member
- 4- Strategy to create further opportunities for children to participate outwith schools
- 5- National Shuttle Time Co-ordinator appointed who communicates and reports to the Continental Confederation regularly
