The BWF's online Shuttle Time module aims to:

- Familiarise users with badminton and the Shuttle Time Programme.
- Provide easy access to the theoretical aspects of the Shuttle Time
 Programme.
- Reduce the requirement for participants to attend a full 1-2 day Shuttle
 Time course, through the provision of blended, online and face-to-face learning.
- Present the content of Shuttle Time in a modern and interactive manner.
- Allows recording and tracking of individual's details.





2. Implementation Process

Shuttle Time Training Course



Face-to-Face Teacher Training Course

1-2 days course designed to give teachers the necessary skills, knowledge and confidence to plan and deliver safe and enjoyable badminton lessons for children using the Shuttle Time resources as a guide. These courses are delivered by Shuttle Time Tutors.

Blended Teacher Training Course

Designed to cover theoretical aspects of the Shuttle Time programme through an online learning module. Practical elements of the Shuttle Time programme are then delivered during a reduced face-to-face course. These courses are delivered by Shuttle Time Tutors.

Physical Education in Schools

Teachers delivering Shuttle Time Lesson Plans and activities to school pupils aged 5-15 years of age.
