Friday 1st March : MS R32, WS R32, MD R32, WD R32 and XD R32.

Saturday 2nd March : All events R16, all events R8.

Sunday 3rd March : All semi-finals and all finals.

Expected playtime Wednesday-Saturday: 09:00-22:00, Sunday: 09:30-16:30.



Entry closing date :

- a. Entries closing date Tuesday 29 January 2019 - 23.59 hours BWF headquarters time, (+ 08:00 GMT).
- b. After the closing date, the BWF Online Entry System will send a notification confirming reception of final entries to all participating Member Associations. Receipt of this notification is the conclusive evidence of reception of entries before the deadline.
- c. The online entry page will close immediately at the time stated above. Late entries will not be accepted.

Entries :

- a. Competitors must be members of clubs belonging to an organisation in membership with the BWF. **Participation is restricted to players born in the year 2001 or later.** (This is the same age limit as used by the German Junior).
- b. The maximum number of competitors (players/pairs) accepted in the tournament is MS 96, WS 96, MD and WD 64, and XD 96.
- c. If the amount of entries exceeds the maximum amount as listed above in section b, a selection of entries will be made in the following order:
 - i. Points on the World Junior Ranking.
 - ii. Foreign players, drawn by lots (no country can have two players/pairs participating before all entered countries have at least one player/pair participating).
 - iii. Home nation players in order of strength as listed by their Member Association.
 - iv. The selection of entries shall be done by BADMINTON EUROPE.
- d. Entries must be done in order of strength.
- e. All entries must be made by using the BWF Online Entry System :

- f. Competitors and officials who need visa for the Netherlands should send an **application for visa not later than 10 January 2019**, to the Tournament Committee. **We cannot accept entries needing visa without such an application.**
- g. Entry fees are € 30,00 per competitor for the singles and € 40,00 per pair for the doubles. The Member Association that enters a player/pair into a BEC Junior Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player/pair. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes.



Payment can be done prior to the start of the tournament by bank transfer according to payment instructions provided by email after registration.

At the venue, cash payment of all fees due is possible before the start of the tournament. For cash payment an additional administrative fee of € 10,00 per payment is applicable.

h. When none of the events has at least 8 competitors, the tournament is cancelled.

i. BADMINTON EUROPE nor Badminton Nederland nor BC Duiwijck is liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings.

Seeding and drawing

Seeding will be done by Badminton Europe. The draw will be made by Badminton Europe on Tuesday 12 February 2019.

System of play

All events will be played according to a knockout system.

Match conditions

a. Competitors must be prepared to play 15 minutes before scheduled time. No exception will be made to this rule.

b. Yonex Aerosensa 50 shuttlecocks will be used exclusively. Shuttles will be free of charge.

c. An umpire will be appointed for each match.

d. During the tournament, a physiotherapist will be available for the competitors, free of charge.

e. For the tournament 6 courts are available.

f. After each final there will be a prize giving ceremony for all players who played the semi finals in that event. Prizes for the winner and the runner up will be a medal (gold-silver) and an envelope with a money amount. The losers of the semi finals receive a bronze medal.

Clothing and advertising

a. Clothing worn by players during play has to be acceptable badminton sports clothing. Each article of clothing may be of any colour or combinations of colours. Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated BWF Statutes, Section 5.2.3: Junior Tournament Regulations 12 to 16.

b. For all BEC Junior Circuit tournaments the name on the back of the shirts is mandatory at all time during play in the semi-finals and finals A player failing to wear the name on his/her shirt when mandatory shall result in an administrative fine of 50,00 EUR.

c. It is mandatory for the semi-finals and finals that partners in doubles wear the same colour of the T-shirt and shorts/skirts. Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of 50,00 EUR.
