Eligible Players	All players of clubs affiliated through their National Associations to the BWF.

Conditions of Play	The tournament will be played in full accordance with the laws of Badminton and General Competition Regulations (GCR) adopted by the BWF as well as the regulations of the Badminton Europe's Elite Circuit. The tournament draw sizes are limited to: (a) 100 matches per day (b) 2 rounds per event per day for the main draw (c) no more than 3 qualifying rounds for a maximum of 8 places in any event (d) if more players/pairs enter the competition than the organisers can accept even in the qualifying rounds the World Ranking shall be used to determine the players/pairs whose entries can be accepted into the qualifying draw and which entry to fill any subsequent vacancy that may arise. Competitors must be prepared to play at the times quoted in the order of play for the events for which they were entered. Competitors can be scratched if not ready to play when called. Players shall not plan their departure less than two (2) hours after their last match is planned to conclude. If a player is unable to compete due to early departure, he/she will be penalised by removal of Elite Circuit ranking points and shall not be awarded prizes or prize money. BADMINTON EUROPE shall propose to BWF that the gained BWF ranking points are also removed (as in §9.5).
	The seeding and the draw will be done by Badminton Europe.

Practice Courts/ Facilities Entries	On 9th June, 17:00 - 20:00 the courts within the venue are put at disposal free of charge. Players can practice on them without registration but should notice that there are only 5 practice courts that might be occupied. In addition players can practice at the Phoenix Badminton Center before or during the tournament on Tuesday and Wednesday (10:00 − 16:00, 8,-€ / court per hour). Littles	All entries must be made by using the BWF Online Entry System. Entries must be submitted no later than Tuesday 12th May 2020 at 23:59 BWF HQ time (GMT +08.00). Players cannot be entered unless they already have a BWF ID-number. In case you wish to enter players who do not have a BWF ID-number yet, please use the Tournament Software to register new players before the closing date of the tournament. Compliance with GCR 7.9: "In making or authorising entries, the member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and disciplinary processes."

Entry Fees	Singles: 40€ per player Doubles: 30€ per player per event The Member Association that enters a player into a BEC Elite Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry date passes. For all the withdrawn players the organiser can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member Association. The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. Withdrawals	Any withdrawal after the Monday immediately preceding the draw, for any reason whatsoever, renders the Member Association concerned liable to an amount of US \$150.00 for the inconvenience caused by the withdrawal (as in \$22.1). Any player not showing up at the tournament, without having been withdrawn in advance, renders the Member Association concerned liable to an additional amount of US\$ 500,00 for the inconvenience caused by the "no show" (as in \$22.2).
Visas	After entering player(s) in the tournament it is the Member Association's responsibility to secure visas for their players – if this is needed. The Tournament Organisers will do everything possible to enable the entered players to get a visa. For assistance to the organisers of the visa paperwork, affected players are asked to submit the visa form at our website no later than 2nd June: http://www.babbgermaninternational.de/index.php?id=1802
Minimum Amount of Entries	It is required that every event in a particular BEC Elite Circuit tournament has at least 8 competitors (i.e. actual competitors, not merely entries). If the required number of competitors is not met, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking, i.e. BEC Elite Circuit Ranking and BWF World Ranking. In accordance with clause 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.1: World Ranking System, the first published main draw of an event must contain at least one entry from a Member Association other than the hosting Association. If an event does not contain at least one entry from a Member Association other than the hosting Association, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking. BADMINTON EUROPE is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings (as in §3.3).
Prize Money	There is no prize money for this tournament.

Official points of arrival: Transport • Bonn main station • CGN airport • Train station Siegburg/Bonn Transport is only free of charge for players staying at the tournament hotel booked through the organiser (for accommodation booking see below). Transport can also be provided for other players from a point of arrival to any hotel in the city area of Bonn but is then charged as follows: • 15€/player from or to one of the train stations • 20€/player from or to CGN airport Coaches travelling with at least two players get free transportation. All players who need a transport are asked to inform us the earliest possible, but not later than 31st May by submitting the transport form at our website: https://www.babbgermaninternational.de/index.php?id=1795 Transportation between the tournament hotel and the venue will be via public transport (about 15 minutes) and is free of charge for players staying at the tournament hotel booked through the organiser. Tickets for the tram will be provided at the tournament hotel and are valid for the whole city area of Bonn. These tickets can also be purchased at the venue by all other players. Players who want to stay at the tournament hotel are asked to inform us the earliest possible, but latest until 8th May by submitting the accommodation form at our website: http://www.babbgermaninternational.de/index.php?id=1791 When informing us later we cannot guarantee that staying at the tournament hotel is possible but will directly inform you about it. After submitting the accommodation form the organiser will confirm the booking and send an invoice which is to be paid via bank transfer to the organiser. Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF General Clothing Regulations Competition Regulations 20 to 24. It is mandatory that partners in doubles wear the same colour of the T-shirt and shorts/skirts at all time during play in both the qualification and the main draw. Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of 100€ (as in §18.2). Medical A physiotherapist will be present in the Sports hall during the tournament and a medical doctor will be on call. **Badminton Integrity** Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament. To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match. Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches. Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE). Food will be provided at the venue. There will be a cafeteria within the venue where players can purchase drinks and healthy fresh cooked real-food. The organiser will provide free WiFi at the venue. Within the venue there will be a stringing service.
