- Team Tournament will be played with preliminary 6 or 8 teams in 2 groups. Friday morning all teams have 1 match for position. Group A winner vs Group B winner etc.
- Every teammatch will contain 6 matches, 1 MS, 1 WS, 1 LD, 1 MD, 2 XD.
- Maximum of two matches per person in a teammatch.
- If a match ends 3–3 a golden set will be played to 11.
