GENERAL: The tournament will be played in accordance with the Laws of Badminton and the Competition Regulations of BWF. The tournament is also played according to the BEC Junior Circuit regulations. In the event of any dispute, the Referee's decision shall be final.

BEC JUNIOR CIRCUIT: The 3 Borders International is part of the official Badminton Europe Junior Circuit 2021 organized by Badminton Europe.

ELIGIBILITY: 1. Members of the French Federation (French players)

2. Member of an association affiliated to BWF (Foreign players)

3. U-19 players singles, doubles and mixed must be born 2003 or later according to BWF regulation

CLOSING DATE: Entries must be submitted no later than **Tuesday, December 15th, 2020 at 11:59 PM** (GMT +08:00).

ACCREDITATION PLAYERS AND COACHES: All Coaches, Officials and Parents taking part at the 3 Borders International Junior will have to fill in individually the accreditation form online:

www.3bij.fr

This will enable us to print an ID card which enables access to the site (security check) as well as being the payment card for the onsite catering service (see chapter below).

BWF ID NUMBER: If your player does not have an existing BWF ID number, you have to make a request to BWF with all necessary information well before our closing date!

DRAW SIZE: U19 MS = 64, WS = 64, MD = 32, WD = 32, XD = 48

LIMITATION: It is required that every event in a particular BEC Junior Circuit tournament has at least 8 competitors (i.e. actual competitors, not merely entries). If the required number of competitors is not met, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

In accordance with regulation 10.4 in Appendix 6 to BWF's General Competition Regulations, an event must contain at least one entry from a Member other than the hosting Member. If an event does not contain at least one entry from a Member other than the hosting Member, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

BADMINTON EUROPE is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings.

COMPLIANCE WITH GENERAL COMPETITION RÉGULATIONS CLAUSE 7.9: "In making or authorising entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary processes."

PLAYING SYSTEM: Knock out system

According to BEC Junior Circuit Regulation 12.1&12.2:

The Member that enters a player/pair into a BEC Junior Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player/pair. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes. It is recommended that the entry fees are paid by bank transfer, but the organizers can accept cash payments at tournaments.

The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. For all the withdrawn players the organisers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member.

SEEDING AND DRAW: Seeding and draws will be carried out by Badminton Europe on December 29th 2020

CLOTHING REGULATION: Please refer to the clothing regulations (BEC Junior Circuit Reg. 13)

VISA: It is the Member responsability to secure visas for their players, if needed. Members shall make sure that visa applications are made early enough.

INSURANCE: The organizer declines all responsibility should injuries or others damages occur. and covering of costs for possible injuries or other damages. It is to each participant to insure himself.

TRAVEL

OFFICIAL POINT OF ARRIVAL: Saint-Louis train station or Bâle-Mulhouse EuroAirport

TRANSPORT: Transfer between Saint-Louis train station or Bâle-Mulhouse EuroAirport and the hall can be arranged upon request addressed to the organizer.

TRAIN: Saint-Louis train station is 5 minutes away from the hall

OFFICIAL HOTELS

ACCOMMODATIONS CONDITIONS

REFUND: After the draw has been made, accommodation cost will not be refunded

PAYMENT: All accomodation costs must be paid before December 31th. Your registration will be confirmed upon reception of your deposit. Should you fail to pay the deposit, your reservation will be cancelled and you will be responsible for arranging your accomodation.

EARLY DEPARTURE: There will be no refund on accommodation when leaving earlier than announced

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.

Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

BADMINTON INTEGRITY

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.
