### Events

**Note: The Current Covid-19 restrictions in Denmark makes the order of play more challenging than normal. We are allowed to assemble 50 people under 21 years in the hall at the same time plus their trainer and officials. Therefore the final order of play will be determined when we know the actual number of participants. But already know we know that we will separate boys and girls with XD's in an overlap period.**

Men's singles, ladies' singles, men's doubles ladies' doubles and mixed doubles.

- The max amounts of entries which can be accepted in each event are: Men's & Women's singles (64), Men's & Women's doubles (32), Mixed doubles (48)
- Each player can play in 3 events/categories.
- If the amount of entries exceeds the amount listed above, a selection of entries will be made in accordance with regulation 6.1.6 of the Badminton Europe U17 Circuit Regulations.
- It is required that every event in a particular BEC U17 Circuit tournament has at least 8 competitors (i.e. actual competitors, not merely entries). If the required number of competitors is not met, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.
- In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least one entry

from a Member other than the hosting Member. If an event does not contain at least one entry from a Member other than the hosting Member, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

- The tournament will be played according to the knockout-system in accordance with the rules of BWF and the regulations of the Badminton Europe U17 Circuit.
- All matches in all events will be played according to the international rules.
- Seeding and the draw will be made by Badminton Europe.

## Eligible players

All players must be from clubs who are members of their National Association, who must be members of Badminton Europe and Badminton World Federation. The players must be born in 2004 or younger. Players must be entered in order of strength.

Singles: DKK 340.00

Doubles: DKK 360.00 per couple.

Shuttles are included in the entry fees.

The Member that enters a player/pair is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player/pair. The entry fee becomes due if a player/pair is entered and has not been withdrawn by Member by midnight CET local time on the closing date.

## **Badminton Integrity**

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.
