	Doping Control Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.
	Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

	Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.

TRANSPORT	Transport will also be provided by the organizer between the official hotels and the tournament hall, free of charge. Taxis or buses will run according to a time schedule.  The organizer is not able to offer free transport for players who have not make their reservations to official hotels, through CBF.  Transportation cost between the airport and official hotels, is at the expense of participants.  Transportation is provided upon request, between Larnaca Airport and the official hotels through KAPNOS AIRPORTS SHUTTLE http://www.kapnosairportshuttle.com  Upon arrival at the bus terminal in Nicosia, you will be taken to your hotel (official hotel only) by a taxi or minibus. The cost of round trip transportation from Larnaca Airport to the official hotel, is €16 per person, payable with the entry fees. If someone travels to Cyprus from Paphos airport, the cost of round trip transportation from Paphos airport to the official hotel is €30 per person, payable with the entry fees.  Note that the Larnaca and Paphos international airports are the only legal airport points of entry to the Republic of Cyprus and are the only arrival airports for the tournament.  Please note that due to Covid19 related restrictions that may apply at the time, use of buses from the airports might not be allowed.  In this case, the alternative option will be a taxi (up to 4 persons) at the cost of €90 - Larnaka Airport (round trip) €220 - Pafos Airport (round trip)  If you want us to arrange transportation, please inform us about your flight details, filling in the attached Travel Details Form by 30th March 2021.
DEPARTURES	Players should not plan their departure less than three (3) hours after their last match is planned to conclude.
COVID19	The tournament will be played without spectators.  Due to the Covid19 pandemic, if there is a resurgence in the number of cases, there is a possibility that the event may be cancelled by the authorities. In addition, there may be entry restrictions for participants that will be coming to Cyprus from countries where the Covid19 cases are high. Such restrictions may lead to flight cancellations, entry quarantine for incoming passengers and/or obligatory negative Covid19 tests before entry is allowed.  The organizers have no responsibility for such restrictions or cancellations and will not cover any costs made by third persons in case of not being able to enter the tournament or a cancellation because of Covid19.  You will need to apply for a Cyprus Flight Pass and depending on the categorization of your country at the time of arrival, might need to have a Covid19 test conducted during the last 72 hours before departure from your

country of origin (for category B) & additionally (for category C) an extra test upon arrival at the airport at the cost of €60.
