EVENTS Men's and women's singles, men's and women's doubles, and mixed doubles The Championships will comprise of the following number of entries in the main tournament:

Men's Singles (MS) 32 Women's Singles (WS) 32 Men's Doubles (MD) 24 Women's Doubles (WD) 24 Mixed Doubles (XD) 24

The number of players in/from the qualification is subject to the final number of entries.

In accordance with regulation § 9.2 and § 9.3 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.1: World Ranking System, an event must contain at least 8 (eight) competitors in the first published version of the main draw. If the required number of competitors is not met in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking, i.e. BEC Elite Circuit Ranking and BWF World Ranking.

In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.1: World Ranking System, the first published version of the main draw of an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member. If an event does not contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

BADMINTON EUROPE is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings.

PAYMENT

The Member that enters a player into a BEC Elite Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes. It is recommended that the entry fees are paid by bank transfer, but the organizers can accept cash payment at tournaments.

PAYMENT: Payment for entry fees needs to be done before 7th of October2021 and we will send out invoices to each association in connection with the final approval of entry list. The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. For all the with drawn players the organizers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member .If no payment has been received after the deadline has passed the organizers will forward the invoice with the registration of deliverance and the copy of the original entry together with the original invoice to BADMINTON EUROPE. Every unpaid invoice for entry fees sent to BADMINTON EUROPE by a tournament organizer following the above-mentioned procedure, shall result in an additional administrative fine of 100,00 EUR for the Member who is addressed in the invoice.

If a player/pair is listed on a "Reserve List", no entry fee is to be paid before being promoted to the Main Draw or Qualification draw. Before the withdrawal deadline has passed, a promotion from the "Reserve List" to the Main Draw or Qualification draw is obligated and will be done automatically, unless the respective player/pair has withdrawn from the "Reserve List" beforehand.

After the withdrawal deadline has passed, the organisers must have such a promotion confirmed in writing by the member/members of the respective player/pair before it takes place. Only when this confirmation has been given, the player/pair is considered as an entry.

Organisers are allowed to refuse entries if Members or their players have outstanding fees from a previous year.

WITHDRAWALS	Please ensure that the organizer will be informed immediately when a player has to withdraw, preferably together with the reason. Any withdrawal after the Monday immediately preceding the draw, for any reason whatsoever, renders the Member concerned liable to an amount of US\$ 150,00 for the inconvenience caused by the withdrawal (as defined in BWF General Competition Regulations). Any player not showing up at the tournament, without having been withdrawn in advance, renders the Member concerned liable to an additional amount of US\$ 500,00 for the inconvenience caused by the "no show" (as defined in BWF General Competition Regulations).
CEREMONIES	Players are not allowed to wear hats or caps during the presentation ceremonies. Rackets may not be carried during presentations. Tracksuits, or clothing as worn during play, will be allowed. No other form of advertising will be permitted. This regulation will be strictly enforced by our stewards prior to each ceremony.
CONDITIONS OF PLAY	The tournament will be played in full accordance with the laws of badminton and the BWF General Competition Regulations as well as the BEC Elite Circuit Regulations. Competitors must be prepared to play at the time determined for the events for which they have entered. Competitors will be scratched if not ready toplay when called. Players shall not plan their departure less than 2 (two) hours after their last match is planned to conclude. If a player is unable to compete due to early departure, he/she will be penalised by removal of Elite Circuit ranking point sand shall not be awarded prizes or prize money. BADMINTON EUROPE shall propose to BWF that the gained BWF ranking points are also removed (Regulation 9.5 in Badminton Europe's Circuit Instructions)

ADVERTISING & CLOTHING Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF General Competition Regulations § 20 to 24. Any breach of these regulations will be forwarded to BWF.

It is mandatory that partners in doubles wear the same colour of the T-shirt and shorts/skirts at all time during play in both the qualification and the main draw. Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of 100,00 EUR.

BADMINTON INTEGRITY

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament. To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match. Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.

DOPING CONTROL

Doping tests can be executed.

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples. Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

BADGES	Entry to the arena for players and officials will be controlled by colour coded name badges. Badges will be issued to all nominated players on arrival to the venue.
TRAVEL	Competitors from abroad are requested to inform the transport manager at <u>transport@czechbadmintonopen.com</u> of type and time of arrival, flight no., with all necessary details. Transportation (pick up): Will be provided as a courtesy from Airport Brno/ Main Bus and Main Train Station Brno to the official hotels only. All transports must be pre-booked via <u>transport@czechbadmintonopen.com</u> by latest 15 th October 2021 in order to guarantee transport.
SHUTTLE TRANSPORT	Transport between the venue and the official tournament hotels will be arranged. The shuttle bus will run according to a time schedule.
LUNCH AND DINNER	It will be possible to buy lunch and dinner in the restaurants of the official hotels. A small snack-bar will be opened in the hall for players and visitors.
HOTELS	 Accommodation in the official hotels must be booked no later than September 25th 2021. Because of covid situation only these 3 hotels are possible to be chosen for your accommodation (see hotels below). These hotels are instructed to keep strict pandemic rules, which can keep tournament participants in required conditions. Accommodation must be booked by e-mail. Details are below in "Accommodation". Please note that there is a limited capacity within each hotel and reservations will be handled on the basis of first come, first served. Your booking e-mail will be answered with information about hotel payment.

The Organizer shall pay the prize money in cash after the last match of the player. Income tax will be 15% deducted.

Force majeure: The organising Member can cancel a tournament in case of force majeure. Such cancellation must be announced at least 15 days before the start of the tournament. If a cancellation is announced less than 15 days before the start of the tournament, then the Member organising the tournament is liable for any expenses incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.). BADMINTON EUROPE is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons because of a cancellation of a tournament.

COVID-19:

Please be aware that the tournament takes place during the current pandemic situation with COVID-19. The conditions for hosting the tournament, as well as hygiene, sanitary and preventive measures will be those determined by the Czech authorities at all times. If the Czech authorities require it, each participant may have to deliver a responsible declaration before participating in the tournament. Should the event be cancelled with short notice by the Czech authorities, due to the COVID-19 situation, beyond the control of both Badminton Europe and the Czech Badminton Federation, neither of them will any costs related to travelling be liable for or accommodation made by players/officials for this event. Each member must ensure that it is allowed to enter Czech Republic in the current circumstances. It is strongly recommended that all participants book flight tickets with a cancellation insurance.
