Eligible Players	All players of clubs affiliated through their National Associations to the BWF.

Condition of Play	The tournament will be played in full accordance with the laws of Badminton and General Competition Regulations adopted by the BWF as well as the regulations of the Badminton Europe's Elite Circuit. The tournament draw sizes are limited to: (a) 100 matches per day (b) 2 rounds per event per day for the main draw (c) no more than 3 qualifying rounds per day for a maximum of 8 places in any event (d) if more players/pairs enter the competition than the organizers can accept even in the qualifying rounds the World Ranking shall be used to determine the players/pairs whose entries can be accepted into the qualifying draw and which entry to fill any subsequent vacancy that may arise. Competitors must be prepared to play at the times quoted in the order of play for the events for which they were entered. Players shall not plan their departure less than two (2) hours after their last match is planned to conclude. If a player is unable to compete due to early departure, he/she will be penalized by removal of Elite Circuit ranking points and shall not be awarded prizes or prize money. BADMINTON EUROPE shall propose to BWF that the gained BWF ranking points are also removed (as in §9.5).

Entries	All entries must be made by using the BWF Online Entry System. Entries must be submitted no later than Tuesday 14 <sup>th</sup> September 2021 at 6:59 PM (GMT +03.00).						
	Players cannot be entered unless they already have a BWF ID- number. In case you wish to enter players who do not have a BWF

Compliance with GCR 7.9: "In making or authorizing entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary processes.".
Entry Fees	<ul> <li>Singles: 40€ per player, Doubles: 30€ per player</li> <li>The Member that enters a player into a tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline has passed.</li> <li>It is recommended that the entry fees are paid by bank transfer, but the organisers can accept cash payment at the tournament <b>before a player's first scheduled match</b>. Withdrawals	SWIFT: BCYPCY2N Any withdrawal after the Monday immediately preceding the draw, for any reason whatsoever, renders the Member concerned liable to an amount of US \$150.00 for the inconvenience caused by the withdrawal (as in §22.1). Any player not showing up at the tournament, without having been withdrawn in advance, renders the Member concerned liable to an additional amount of US\$ 500,00 for the inconvenience caused by the "no show"(as in §22.2). The payment of withdrawal fees and "no shows" shall be collected by the BWF and the amount concerning the withdrawal fees shall be forwarded to the organisers after US\$ 100,00 per withdrawal is retained by the BWF. However, if the player was entered by the

	Member under whose jurisdiction the competition is held, then the whole payment shall be retained by the BWF (as in §22.3). Not succeeding in getting a visa for the tournament as a player is not a valid reason to discard a fine for withdrawal or no show (as in §22.4).

Minimum Amount of Entries	In accordance with regulation § 9.2 and § 9.3 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.1: World Ranking System, an event must contain at least 8 (eight) competitors in the first published version of the main draw. If the required number of competitors is not met in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking, i.e. BEC Elite Circuit Ranking and BWF World Ranking. In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.1: World Ranking System, the first published version of the main draw of an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member. If an event does not contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking. BADMINTON EUROPE is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings. (as in §3.3).
Prize Money	There is no prize money for this tournament.
Clothing	Color, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF General Competition Regulations 20 to 24. Any breach of these regulations will be forwarded to BWF. (as in §18.1) It is mandatory that partners in doubles wear the same color of the T- shirt and shorts/skirts at all time during play in both the qualification and the main draw. Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of $100 \in$ (as in §18.2).

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples. Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE). COVID-19	The COVID-19 section on our website www.badmintoncyprus.com will be updated regularly according to the Ministry of Health guidelines. <b>CvprusFlightPass</b> In order to support the containment of COVID-19 in Cyprus all inbound passengers are required to present a 'flight pass' to fly prior to boarding. https://cyprusflightpass.gov.cy/ To receive a <b>CyprusFlightPass</b> each passenger will need to: 1. Create an account 2. Enter personal information 3. Add your flight details 4. Make legal declarations 5. You may be required to provide evidence of a negative COVID-19 test 6. In the case of minors accompanied or unaccompanied passengers under the age of 18, the Information will be provided and the form will be completed and signed on behalf of the minors, by the custodian parent (s) or the adoptive parent (s) / legal guardian (s) / legal representative(s) On successful completion of your application you will receive a report including your <b>CyprusFlightPass</b> and all relevant information

	which you will be asked to present prior to boarding and on arrival at immigration.

	Persons traveling from <u>GREEN</u> countries will not need to demonstrate a negative PCR test for COVID-19 when traveling to Cyprus; they only need to provide certain information and solemn declarations.							
	Persons traveling from <b>ORANGE</b> countries are required to undergo a molecular test at a certified lab, with the sample taken during the last 72 hours prior to flight departure and upload a certificate that demonstrates a negative PCR for COVID-19, on the Cyprus Flight Pass Platform.							
	Persons travelling from <u><b>RED</b></u> countries are required to undergo molecular test at a certified lab, with the sample taken during the last 72 hours prior to flight departure and upload a certificate that demonstrated a negative PCR for COVID-19, on the Cyprus Flight Pass Platform. They will also need to pay for and undergo a molecular PCR test upon arrival to Cyprus, the cost of which is €30 at Larnaca Airport; results of the test will be available within 3 hours and will be shared with the traveller by SMS.

Travelers who can prove that they have received all necessary doses of an authorized vaccine, will not be required to undergo any tests to visit Cyprus, irrespective of colour-categorization of their country of departure. Moreover, they will not be placed in quarantine, even in the case when they are close contacts of a positive COVID-19 case. The above facilitation will be valid from the date that a vaccine has been fully administered, with the exception of Johnson and Johnson, where the facilitation will be valid two weeks after vaccination.
<ul><li>Prior to travel, a copy of the vaccination certificate must be uploaded onto the Cyprus Flight Pass platform and certain vaccination details must also be provided.</li><li>It should be noted that the Republic of Cyprus still reserves the right</li></ul>
to randomly test any arriving flight.
