U19: players born in 2003 or later.

Group A singles are played in U-11; U-13; U-15; U-17; U-19 Group B singles are played in U-13; U-15; U-17 Doubles and mixed doubles are played in U-13; U-15; U-17; U-19 A player can participate in a maximum of three events: one singles, one doubles and one mixed doubles.

Draw

In the singles events, preliminary pools of 3 or 4 players will be played. Main draw will be played in a knock-out system. The doubles events will be played in a knock-out system.
