GENERAL

The tournament will be played in accordance with the Laws of Badminton, BWF's General Competition Regulations and Badminton Europe's Junior Circuit Regulations. In the event of any dispute, the Referee's decision shall be final.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Ukrainian Badminton license for the Ukrainian players.
- 2. Foreign players have to be members of a Member affiliated to the BWF.
- 3. According to BWF rules U19 boys/girls: singles, doubles and mixed.

ENTRIES

Entries must be done in order of strength.

64 in singles, 48 in men's and women's doubles and 48 in mixed doubles will be accepted.

If the amount of entries exceeds the maximum amount selection of entries shall be done by BADMINTON EUROPE.

In accordance with regulation § 9.2 and § 9.3 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 8 (eight) competitors in the first published version of the main draw. If the required number of competitors is not met in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw. If an event does not contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

Entries must be made by a Member of which the player/pair is a member. All entries must be made by using the BWF Online Entry System:

ENTRY FEES Singles: 30 € per player

Doubles & Mixed: 25 € per player / 50 € per pair

The Member that enters a player/pair into a BEC Junior Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player/pair. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes. The organizers accept cash payments at tournaments.

The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. For all the withdrawn players the organizers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member.

CLOTHING AND ADVERTISING

Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF Statutes, Section 5.2.3: Junior Tournament Regulations § 12 to 16. A player violating these regulations shall be penalised by an administrative fine of 50,00 EUR.

It is mandatory for the semi-finals and finals that partners in doubles wear the same colour of the T-shirt and shorts/skirts. Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of $50,00~{\rm EUR}$

COVID-19:

Please be aware that the tournament takes place during the current pandemic situation with COVID-19. The conditions for hosting the tournament, as well as hygiene, sanitary and preventive measures, will be those determined by the Ukranian authorities at all times. If the Ukrainian authorities require it, each participant may have to deliver a responsible declaration before participating in the tournament. Should the event be cancelled with short notice by the Ukrainianian authorities, due to the COVID-19 situation, beyond the control of both Badminton Europe and the Ukrainian Badminton Federation, neither of them will be liable for any costs related to travelling or accommodation made by players/officials for this event. Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

BADMINTON INTEGRITY

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.
