Regulation & Integrity: The tournament will be played in accordance with the Laws of Badminton and the General Competition regulations of the BWF as well as with the **Badminton Europe U17 Circuit Regulations.**

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.

Compliance with General Competition Regulations Clause 7.9

GCR 7.9: *"In making or authorising entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary processes."*

- Eligibility: All players must be members of an association affiliated to the BWF. Open for players according to the current **Badminton Europe-/ BWF-age limit**.
- Advertising and clothing: Advertising on clothing and colour of clothing shall be regulated by the **BWF Competition Regulations and the BEC U17 Circuit Regulations**.
- Entries: All entries must be made by using the **BWF Online Entry System**. Players can't be entered unless they already have a **BWF ID number**.

In accordance with regulation § 9.2 and § 9.3 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 8 (eight) competitors in the first published version of the main draw. If the required number of competitors is not met in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw. If an event does not contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

Badminton Europe is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings.

- Entry deadline: **17 MAY 2022, 23:59 BWF Headquarters time (17:59 CET)**
- Draw: Seeding and draw will be carried out by **Badminton Europe**
- Date of draw: 31 May 2022
- Withdrawals: Players must contact the organizer immediately if they have to withdraw from the competition and inform about the reason(s) of withdrawal.
- Entry Fees: Singles: **36 €/each** player
Doubles: **21 €/each** player (42 €/each pair)
shuttles & physio therapist included!

The Member that enters a player/pair into a **BEC U17 Circuit tournament** is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player/pair. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and hasn't been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes!

All entry fees should be paid by BANK transfer or by cash to the Organizer after team managers meeting (TMM).
