### Events

**Note: The Current Covid-19 restrictions in Denmark are all lifted since April 1<sup>st</sup> 2022, We do not expect any changes to that situation, never the less, the final order of play will be determined when we know the actual number of participants in the different categories.**

Men's singles, ladies' singles, men's doubles ladies' doubles and mixed doubles.

- The maximum amounts of entries which can be accepted in each event are:  
Men's & Women's singles (96), Men's & Women's doubles (48), Mixed doubles (48). Depending on number of participants order of play on Thursday will be adjusted – plan is to start last rounds of play at app. 20.00 Thursday. **As soon as we have the final number of entries, we will adjust the rough order of play and issue to all organizations in order to plan travel accordingly. We hope that we can play on three days, and our intention is to play on three days (Friday to Sunday).**
- Each player can play in 3 events/categories.
- If the amount of entries exceeds the amount listed above, a selection of entries will be made in accordance with regulation 6.1.6 of the Badminton Europe U17 Circuit Regulations.
- In accordance with regulation § 9.2 and § 9.3 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 8 (eight) competitors in the first published version of the main draw. If the required number of competitors is not met in the first published version of

the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking. In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw. If an event does not contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking. BADMINTON EUROPE is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings.

- The tournament will be played according to the knockout-system in accordance with the rules of BWF and the regulations of the Badminton Europe U17 Circuit.
- All matches in all events will be played according to the international rules.
- Seeding and the draw will be made by Badminton Europe.

## Eligible players

All players must be from clubs who are members of their National Association, who must be members of Badminton Europe and Badminton World Federation. The players must be born in 2006 or younger. Players must be entered in order of strength.

Signup to doubles with no partner (x-partner) is not possible – all pairs must be entered via the national organisations BWF entry including mixed nationality pairs. Players interested in x partnership can send request to the tournament organizers email in due time before the entry deadline – in order to be matched up with others in similar position – Please send provide contact details in order for the organizer to expedite requests in due time

Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF Statutes, Section 5.2.3: Junior Tournament Regulations § 12 to 16. For all BEC U17 Circuit tournaments the name on the back of the shirt is optional.

## Entry fees

Entry fees shall be paid only on a bank transfer [IBAN no. DK3381251250137342 and Swift code SPNODK22] please indicate paying organization in the transfer details, invoices will be issued on request. Deadline for payment is August 12<sup>th</sup>. 2022 (after the signup deadline)

Singles: DKK 340.00 (approx. 45 euro)  
Doubles: DKK 360.00 per couple. (approx. 50 euro)

Shuttles are included in the entry fees.



The Member that enters a player/pair into a BEC U17 Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player/pair. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes. The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. For all the withdrawn players the organizers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member.

All players incl. Danish players must enter through their National Member.

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match. Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.
