Event:

- BEC U17
- MS, WS, MD, WD & XD All events will be played as a knock out stage
- A player can participate in a maximum of three events: <u>one singles, one doubles</u> and one mixed doubles
- NOTE <u>If a player participates in both tournaments, Li-Ning Zagreb U17 Open</u> and Li-Ning Zagreb Youth Open, tournaments are counted as one.

• Age group – born 2006 or later

Entries:

The number of players/pairs to be accepted for the main draw:

- Singles: 64
- Men's and women's doubles: 32
- Mixed doubles: 48

In accordance with regulation § 9.2 and § 9.3 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 8 (eight) competitors in the first published version of the main draw. If the required number of competitors is not met in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw. If an event does not contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

BADMINTON EUROPE is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings.











Entry fees:

- Singles 30 EUR
- Doubles 25 EUR per player per event

The Member that enters a player/pair into a BEC U17 Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player/pair. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes. It is recommended that the entry fees are paid by bank transfer, but cash payments will be accepted at tournaments.

The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. For all the withdrawn players the organisers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member.

Visa:

Doping Control:

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples. Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

COVID-19:

Please be aware that the tournament takes place during the current pandemic situation with COVID-19. The conditions for hosting the tournament, as well as hygiene, sanitary and preventive measures will be those determined by the Croatian authorities at all times. If the Croatian authorities require it, each participant may have to deliver a responsible declaration before participating in the tournament. Should the event be cancelled with short notice by the Croatian authorities, due to the COVID-19 situation, beyond the control of both Badminton Europe and the Croatian Badminton Federation, neither of them will be liable for any costs related to travelling or accommodation made by players/officials for this event. Each member must ensure through the following web address https://reopen.europa.eu/en/map/HRV/7002 that it is allowed to enter Croatia in the

current circumstances. It is strongly recommended that all participants book flight tickets with a cancellation insurance.

Badminton Integrity:

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament. To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.




Host city:
