- Bring in more fans from the start of the event


How?

- Matches picked according to the interest of the host



RENEWED EMWTC COMPETITION FORMAT

- EMWTC split into Qualification and Final stage
- Qualification stage held in December
- Final stage with top 8 Men and 8 Women teams
- 5 days of exciting competition on 4 courts
- Men and Women team for host nation automatically qualified
