Others	<p><u>Important remark I</u></p> <p>Competition schedule will be made after the draw; the maximum number of matches allowed per day will be in accordance with article 6.1.5 of BEC U17 Circuit Regulations; a maximum of 3 rounds per event, per day are allowed to be played in the tournament</p> <p><u>Important remark II: Doping Control</u></p> <p>Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples. Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE). To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match. Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a match(es).
