07	Brand of Shuttles	Yonex Aerosensa 50 exclusively. Shuttles will be free of charge provided for each match to play.
08	Courts	The tournament will be played on a normal sports floor with lines for badminton only. The correct number of courts will be determined after conducting the draw. (6 courts possible).

10	Fees	Entry fees are € 47,50 per competitor for the singles and € 75,00 per pair for the doubles. The Member that enters a player/pair into a BEC Junior Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player/pair. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes. The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. For all the withdrawn players the organisers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member. Payment can be done prior to the start of the tournament by bank transfer according to payment instructions provided by email, after registration we shall send the necessary data how to pay the entry fees. At the venue, cash payment of all fees due is possible before the start of the tournament.

		For cash payment an additional administrative fee of € 10,- per payment is applicable. Organisers are allowed to refuse entries if Members or their players have outstanding fees from a previous year.
11	Visa	Competitors and officials who need visa for the Netherlands should send an application for visa not later than 10 January 2025 to the Tournament Committee. We cannot accept entries needing visa without such an application.

If the required number of competitors is not met in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.</p> <p>In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw. If an event does not contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.</p> <p>When none of the events has at least 8 competitors, the tournament is cancelled.</p>

18	Practice	<p>Practice courts are available during the tournament. For reservations contact the transport office in the tournament venue.</p> <p>For warming up 3 courts are available in the tournament venue.</p>																		
19	Clothing / Advertising	<p>Clothing worn by players during play has to be acceptable badminton sports clothing. Each article of clothing may be of any colour or combinations of colours. Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF Statutes, Section 5.2.3: Junior Tournament Regulations § 12 to 16. A player violating these regulations shall be penalised by an administrative fine of 50,00 EUR.</p> <p>It is mandatory for the semi-finals and finals that partners in doubles wear the same colour of the T-shirt and shorts/skirts.</p> <p>Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of € 50,-</p>																		
20	Medical	During the tournament, a physiotherapist will be available for the competitors, free of charge.																		
21	Match Conditions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Competitors must be prepared to play 15 minutes before scheduled time. No exception will be made to this rule. An umpire and a service judge will be appointed for each match. 																		
22	Stringing	Stringing facilities will be offered in the venue for acceptable prices to pay by the competitor.																		
23	Compliance with GCR Clause 7.9	"In making or authorising entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary processes."																		
24	Badminton Integrity	<p>Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention Of The Manipulation Of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.</p> <p>To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.</p>

The organizer will NOT be responsible for any injury sustained, at any time, by any player or official arising from his participation in these Championships.
