LEVEL: Junior International series

VENUE: Sportenum, allée des Sports 68300 SAINT-LOUIS (FRANCE)

GENERAL: The tournament will be played in accordance with the Laws of Badminton and the Competition Regulations of BWF. The tournament is also played according to the BEC Junior Circuit regulations. In the event of any dispute, the Referee's decision shall be final.

BEC JUNIOR CIRCUIT: The YONEX 3 Borders International is part of the official Badminton Europe Junior Circuit 2025 organized by Badminton Europe.

ELIGIBILITY: 1. Members of the French Federation (French players)

- 2. Member of an association affiliated to BWF (Foreign players)
- 3. U-19 players singles, doubles and mixed must be born 2007 or later according to BWF regulation











REGISTRATION 1

BWF ONLINE U 19: All entries must be made by using the BWF Online Entry System: https://bwf.tournamentsoftware.com/tournament/9C77F478-F039-44B8-823E-A1F7232268AF

CLOSING DATE: Entries must be submitted no later than Tuesday, April 29th, 2025 at 11:59 PM (GMT +08:00).

BWF ID NUMBER: Players cannot be entered unless they already have a BWF ID-number. In case you wish to enter players, who do not have a BWF ID-number, please contact the BWF office well in advance of the tournament, so that the players concerned can receive a BWF ID-number before the closing date of the tournament. No late entries will be accepted.

DRAW SIZE: U19 MS = 64, WS = 64, MD = 32, WD = 32, XD = 48

LIMITATION: In accordance with regulation § 9.2 and § 9.3 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 8 (eight) competitors in the first published version of the main draw. If the required number of competitors is not met in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw. If an event does not contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

Badminton Europe is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings.

COMPLIANCE WITH GENERAL COMPETITION RÉGULATIONS CLAUSE 7.9: "In making or authorising entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary processes."

PLAYING SYSTEM: Knock out system

According to BEC Junior Circuit Regulation 12.1&12.2:

The Member that enters a player/pair into a BEC Junior Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player/pair. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes. It is recommended that the entry fees are paid by bank transfer, but the organizers can accept cash payments at tournaments.

The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. For all the withdrawn players the organisers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member.

SEEDING AND DRAW: Seeding and draws will be carried out by Badminton Europe on **Tuesday, May 20th 2025**

INSURANCE: The organizer declines all responsibility should injuries or others damages occur and covering of costs for possible injuries or other damages. It is to each participant to insure himself.











COMPETITION 1

COURTS: 5 « YONEX » mats

SHUTLLES: YONEX AEROSENSA AS-30

PRIZES: Cups/pratical prizes for the winner and finalist of each event. The tournament is endowed with 2500

euros of prizes

MEDICAL TEAM: A free physiotherapist will be available during the competition.

DOPING TESTING: Doping testing may be carried out on a random basis at any time during and shortly after the tournament.

DOPING CONTROL: Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.

Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

BADMINTON INTEGRITY: Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a match(es).

COMPETITION 2

STRINGING SERVICE: A stringing service will be available for the players during the tournament on Friday and Saturday. The price is 15 euros for hanging and 22 euros for hanging + stringing.

CLOTHING REGULATIONS: Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF Statutes, section 5.2.3: Junior Tournament Regulations § 12 to 16. A player violating these regulations shall be penalised by an administrative fine of 50,00 euros.

It is mandatory for the semi-finals and finals that partners in doubles wear the same colour of the T-shirt and shorts/skirts. Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of 50,00 euros.

OFFICIAL POINT OF ARRIVAL: Saint-Louis train station or Bâle-Mulhouse EuroAirport



MEALS DURING THE TOURNAMENT

MEALS: A catering service will be in place at the Sportenum which will offer a choice of warm and cold sport meals as well as snacks and beverages during the entire day at a decent price. A full list will be accessible at our web site before the event.

The catering service will start on Thursday May 30th until Sunday June 2th midday.

PAYEMENT METHOD AT THE CATERING SERVICE: All players and coaches will receive an ID at their arrival which will also serve as payment card for all food and beverage taken at the catering service. This card has to be preloaded in euros before usage. Not used credit will be refunded in cash only at the end of the tournament. It is possible to order preloaded cards with a defined amount (e.g. 20 euros) for each member of your team with the travel/hotel form. The payment has to be made before the first use of the cards.


