

Practice sessions will be available in the same tournament hall on Wednesday 3rd April from 15:00. The schedule will be published on the tournament website. For booking courts, please fill in the Google form on the website mentioned above. Bookings will be accepted up to 27th March, 2024.

The final frame schedule (with the exact planned conclusion of all matches) shall be made at least 20 days before the start of the tournament and shall be published on the organiser's website.

Players shall not plan their departure less than 2 (two) hours after their last match is planned to conclude. If a player is unable to compete due to early departure, he/she shall be penalised by Forfeiture of rewards (removal of Elite Circuit ranking points and shall not be awarded prizes or prize money). Badminton Europe shall propose to BWF that the gained BWF ranking points are also removed.

Eligible players: Players who are member with a Federation/Association affiliated with BWF are eligible to take part in this tournament. The BE Elite Circuit Regulations apply throughout this tournament.

System: Singles - draws with knock-out system

Doubles - draws with knock-out system

Mixed Doubles - draws with knock-out system

Tournament shuttle: Official tournament shuttle is Victor MasterAce

Participants will not be allowed to play with other shuttles Shuttles for practice session can be bought at the venue

Maximum number of entries: MS/WS: 32 - MD/XD: 24 - WD: 24

In accordance with regulation § 9.2 and § 9.3 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.1: World Ranking System, an event must contain at least 8 (eight) competitors in the first published version of the main draw. If the required number of competitors is not met in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking, i.e. BEC Elite Circuit Ranking and BWF World Ranking.

In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.1: World Ranking System, the first published version of the main draw of an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member. If an event does not contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

Badminton Europe is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings.

Entries: All entries must be made by using the BWF Online Entry System using this link of Tournament Software: https://bwf.tournamentsoftware.com/tournament/A6C91D48-75C3-4025-9229-F67CA63C6BDB

The Member that enters a player into a BEC Elite Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes. It is recommended that the entry fees are paid by bank transfer, but the organisers can accept cash payment at tournaments.

The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. For all the withdrawn players the organisers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member.

If a player/pair is listed on a "Reserve List", no entry fee is to be paid before being promoted to the Main Draw or Qualification draw.

Before the withdrawal deadline has passed, a promotion from the "Reserve List" to the Main Draw or Qualification draw is obligated and will be done automatically, unless the respective player/pair has withdrawn from the "Reserve List" beforehand.

After the withdrawal deadline has passed, the organisers must have such a promotion confirmed in writing by the Member/Members of the respective player/pair before it takes place. Only when this confirmation has been given, the player/pair is considered as an entry. The respective Member(s) need(s) to confirm the promotion within 48h after the message has been sent by the organisers or latest at the start of the Team Managers Meeting if it takes place less than 48h after the message has been sent. If no confirmation is given within this timeframe, it will be considered as the player/pair not accepting the promotion.

Please ensure that the organizers are informed immediately when a player has to withdraw, preferably together with the reason.

Any withdrawal after the Monday immediately preceding the draw, for any reason whatsoever, renders the Member concerned liable to an amount of US\$ 150,00 for the inconvenience caused by the withdrawal (as defined in BWF General Competition Regulations).

Any player not showing up for a match at the tournament, without having been withdrawn in advance, renders the Member concerned liable to an additional amount of US\$ 500,00 for the inconvenience caused by the "no show" (as defined in BWF General Competition Regulations).

Compliance with General Competition Regulations Clause 7.9

GCR 7.9: "In making or authorizing entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary processes."

Clothing/Advertising: Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF General Regulations § 20 to 24. Any breach of these regulations will be forwarded to BWF.

It is mandatory that partners in doubles wear the same colour of the T-shirt and shorts/skirts at all time during play in both the qualification and the main draw. Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of 100,00 EUR.

Entry fees: Singles - €45.00 per player Doubles - €40.00 per player Mixed - €40.00 per player

Visas: After entering one or more players in the tournament, it is the Member's responsibility to secure visas for their players - if this is needed. Members must make sure that visa applications are made early enough. The tournaments organisers will have to do everything possible to enable the entered players to get a visa.

If you require any assistance from the organiser with Visa paperwork, this needs to be done no later than 4th March 2024

The following information regarding the foreigner being invited shall be given:

- name (-s) and surname;
- citizenship (nationality);
- date and place of birth;
- the address of the place of residence;
- the location (office) where the visa application will likely be submitted
- valid passport details

It is recommended that Member and/or Organisers purchase a proper Insurance Policy that would cover their potential legal liability.

BADMINTON MALTA is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings.

Prize money: There is no prize money for this tournament.

Badminton Shop: A Victor badminton shop will be setup at the venue throughout the tournament days.

Restringing: Will be available at the venue for €20.00 per racket including strings, or €10.00 per racket excluding strings. Participants using Victor equipment will benefit from a discount.

Catering: Food and drinks can be purchased at the venue throughout the tournament days.



Accommodation: Arrangements are currently being made with the hotel, details of which will be published in due course on the website mentioned on page 2. Bookings can also be made through the same link before the 9th March, 2024.

Transport: Official point of arrival is Malta International Airport. Transport will be provided for free for those using official hotels on receipt of arrival and departure details. Transport will also be provided between the official hotel and the venue, for the duration of the event.

Badminton Integrity

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of the Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a match(es).

Doping Control

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples. Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE). Force Majeure

The organising Member can cancel a tournament in case of force majeure. Such cancellation must be announced at least 15 days before the start of the tournament. If a cancellation is announced less than 15 days before the start of the tournament, then the Member organising the tournament is liable for any expenses incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.). Badminton Europe is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons because of a cancellation of a tournament.
